

What is IS Essentials?

IS Essentials is an infrastructure sustainability rating tool that encompasses the Design and Construction phases of an infrastructure project and is applicable across all asset types.

The rating tool is designed to drive sustainability outcomes in material areas and is able to be tailored to assets with capital values less than \$100 Million.




IS Essentials Training Toolkit

The IS Essentials training toolkit provides participants with the knowledge required to navigate the IS Rating Portal, apply the IS Essentials Technical Manual, and supporting guidelines to an infrastructure project from design through to completed construction.

Apply your IS Design & As Built knowledge and explore the intricacies of undertaking an IS Essentials rating. The training toolkit and supporting materials will empower you to measure sustainability and quadruple bottom line performance of infrastructure projects of up to \$100M capex.

Steps to become an ISAP:

- 1. Register for and complete the CORE training course, IS Rating Skills.
- 2. Register for the STANDARD training course relevant to the life-cycle stage you work within.
- 3. Complete the STANDARD training course including end of course test & certificate.
- 4. Complete the ISAP accreditation exam.
- 5. Maintain your ISAP accreditation annually.



Frequently asked questions

Q. I am a current Infrastructure Sustainability Accredited Professional (ISAP), how do I access this training?

- You can register for the IS Essentials training toolkit at no cost until 31st July 2024. From August 2024 there will be a fee to undertake IS Essentials modules.
- From 1st August 2024 you must have completed IS Design and As Built (IS D&AB) training prior to undertaking IS Essentials.

Q.I have not previously completed IS for Professionals pathway training, how do I access this training?

- Register for and undertake IS Rating Skills training.
- Register for IS Design and As Built (including Essentials)
- IS Essentials training toolkit is included in your registration and available upon completion of IS Design and As Built.

Q. My ISAP accreditation has expired.

- You are required to undertake IS Rating Skills and IS Design and As Built training.
- IS Essentials modules will be included as part of IS Design and As Built training.




How does it work?




